

SMAC INDOOR TRACK SERIES**JAMAICAN SETS NEW ALL-TIME MARKS IN FIELD EVENTS**

NORTHAMPTON - JAN. 23, 2011

Warren Gray of Kingston, Jamaica set two new all-time marks in the field events at the third and final SMAC Indoor Track Meet of the 2011 season. In what has already been a dazzling season in terms of attendance and sprint speed, Gray showed his prowess in the men's long jump and high jump by leaping to the No. 2 and No. 4 performances of all-time in the 24 year history of the track series. Gray soared to a mark of 22' 4 1/2" in the second round of the long jump to win by almost a foot over Justin Roberts who also made the top ten all-time list with a mark of 21' 6". In the high jump, Gray took several attempts at a new meet record height of 6' 8 1/4", but had to settle with a winning height of 6' 6", which equalled the 4th best jump in the history of the series. Gray also had a hand in setting a new meet record in the men's 4 x 200 meter relay as he helped his fellow "AIC All-Stars" to set the record with a blazing 1:32.15, besting the mark set last week at meet # 2 of the 2011 series by the "Hartford All-Stars."

Two of Gray's teammates on the 4 x 200 relay, Damien Brigham and Carlton Wildman, scorched the track in the men's 200 with identical times of 22.91. Brigham won the event by thousandths of a second based on FinishLynx timing, although both men are credited with equalling the fourth fastest time ever at these meets.

After many years of competing at these meets, Sam Belcher of Deerfield and the Sugarloaf Mountain Athletic Club finally won the men's mile with a superb time of 4:39.78 to best Fred Quesada of Freeport, Maine who posted a time of 4:53.92.

In one of the most stirring battles of the evening, Jason Beaver of Agawam held off a hard charging Liam Sullivan of SMAC to set a new age 6 to 9 record in the boys' 400 meters in 71.01.
